

THE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THE VISUAL ARTS

The Association proudly announces the seventh annual scholarship for freshmen for the 2014/15 school year!

1. This scholarship shall be awarded to an applicant who meets these criteria:
 - a. Must submit samples of past work for review. Works may be two-dimensional, three-dimensional, electronic, video, or film. Full details are specified by the Art Department's Criteria for the Alumni Association Scholarship.
 - b. Must be registered for admission to Archbishop Wood High School in September of the year that the award is granted.
 - c. All applicants must submit an application essay, including a history of the candidate's education and past experience in the arts.
2. A Review Committee will be lead by the chairperson of the Fine Arts Department will judge applications or other art teacher designated by the Chair, a knowledgeable faculty member chosen by the Administration, and an AP Art student.
3. The essay and the portfolio must be submitted by February 5, 2014 of the candidate's 8th grade year. Portfolios can be delivered to the Advancement Office, Room 237 in the South Building.

All scholarships are subject to annual review by the appropriate school authorities. Subsequent aid may be suspended or cancelled for lack of participation in school art related activities, lack of a "B" average in semester grades, or lack of an appropriate discipline record.
