## THE DOYLE FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

The Alumni Association is pleased to announce a CONTINUING scholarship for an incoming freshman, effective in September 2014. This is a funded tuition assistance grant of \$2,500 for Archbishop Wood High School.

The Doyle Family Scholarship was founded by Lawrence Doyle, Class of 1989, of Trappe, PA. It is also supported by Mr. Doyle's four sisters: Jeannie Doyle O'Neill, Class of 1979, of St. Davids, PA; Nancy Doyle, Class of 1980, of Philadelphia, PA; Carolyn Doyle Bjornson, Class of 1982, of Philadelphia, PA; and Missy Doyle Torkelson, Class of 1985, of Napa, CA.

Applicants for this scholarship must be registered to attend Archbishop Wood High School in September 2014 and continue to meet the following requirements:

- a. Must be a member of at least one school athletic team, club, activity or a member of the Archbishop Wood High School Marching Unit
- b. Must provide a pastor's letter attached to the application letter
- c. Must maintain a "B" average each semester at Archbishop Wood High School
- d. Must be the child of a family whose total income is less than ninety-five thousand dollars (\$95,000) in the year of application.

Letters of application must answer this question:

"Imagine someone has written a biography about you. The author has focused on your life at age 40. What accomplishments have you achieved and how would you like to be described as a person?"

Applications must be postmarked by Friday, February 14, 2014 and sent to Timothy P. Dunn, Director of Institutional Advancement, Archbishop Wood High School, and 655 York Road, Warminster, PA 18974. Letters of application must include the student's name, parent's name, and a mailing address.
