THE KELLY RICHARDS SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE PERFORMING ARTS

The Association proudly announces the seventh annual scholarship for freshmen for the 2016/2017 school year!

1. The purpose of the award is to provide two partial scholarships of \$1,000 per year to incoming freshmen in each of the students' four years providing they maintain full membership in the Theater or Music departments and meet the other criteria specified below.
2. These scholarships shall be awarded to applicants who meet these criteria:
 - A. Must become and remain a member of the Archbishop Wood High School Concert Band/String Ensemble or a member of the Vocal/Theater Department.
 - B. Must maintain a "B" average and an acceptable discipline record each semester at Archbishop Wood High School.
3. Applicants for these scholarships must audition before the Music Director and her staff. Incoming freshman applicants shall apply to the Music Director in writing specifying their past instructional and performance history. The Director will schedule the audition and announce the winners by March, 2016.
4. All scholarships are subject to an annual review by the appropriate school authorities. The Administration may at its sole discretion suspend or cancel subsequent aid to any scholarship holder who no longer meets the specified criteria.

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Hirschmann Family Scholarship

All registered incoming 9th graders at Archbishop Wood High School are eligible for the Hirschmann Family Scholarship. This is a \$1,200 funded grant for the 2016/17 School year. This scholarship will continue for four years if the student remains in good standing. The recipient will be selected by the Hirschmann Board according to these criteria: be in good academic standing, be a good citizen of his/her grade school community, be a member of at least one team or activity, and must have some financial need. Please answer the following questions if you want the Hirschmann Board to consider you for the scholarship.

1. Why is it important for you to pursue your high school education at Archbishop Wood?
2. What is the achievement or skill that you are most proud of?
3. What contribution do you hope to make to Archbishop Wood?
4. Please briefly list your activities, hobbies, work experience, community involvement, and any other special circumstances you want the Board to consider.

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WOOD ALUMNI ASSOCIATION **FINE ART SCHOLARSHIP** **CRITERIA FOR 8TH GRADE STUDENTS**

ELIGIBILITY:

1. The Candidate will be enrolled as a student at Archbishop Wood High School in the 9th Grade.
2. The Candidate will submit a portfolio to the review board of not less than 10 nor more than 20 pieces by February 5th, 2016.
3. The Candidate will submit a brief 200 to 500-word essay with their portfolio to the review board.
4. The Candidate will submit a Document certifying that all work is original.
5. The Candidate will submit an inventory of all works.

REQUIREMENTS:

Essay: The Candidate will write a brief Essay of not less than 200 words and not more than 500 words to include the following:

1. The Candidate's experience in art including classes taken in elementary school and extra-curricular classes outside of school.
2. A brief description of the Candidate's experience of art.
3. A brief description of the materials used by the Candidate in his/her artwork.
4. A brief description of what the process of creating art means to the Candidate.
5. A brief description of how the Candidate will use art in their high school career.
6. All Standard English will count, including: grammar, punctuation, syntax, spelling and sentence construction.

Portfolio Requirements:

1. The Candidate will submit a Portfolio of their original works and the essay as described above.
 - A. The Candidate and a parent or guardian must sign the statement attesting to the fact that the works are their original creations having been made within the last two years.
 - B. The Candidate must inventory the works in the Portfolio on the Inventory form, sign it and have it signed by the parent or guardian.
 - C. The works may be in any media.
 - D. The actual works submitted may not exceed 18" X 24".
 - E. Works larger than 18" X 24" may be submitted in slide format or on CD.

- F. The works may not be framed but may be matted. Un-matted works will not be penalized in any way.
- G. No fewer than five actual, un-photographed works may be submitted.
- H. Photographed works may not be duplicated as actual works.
- I. The Candidate may submit no more than 20 works and no fewer than 10.
- J. Works should be representative of the Candidate's exploration of art and media and their experience of art.
- K. The Candidate will be given a number to insure anonymity by the Eligibility Committee. This number must be placed on all application materials, on every work of art submitted, and on every slide as well as the actual container in which the works are carried.

Requirements for continuation of the scholarship:

- A. The Candidate will maintain an 80 average in all academic subjects.
- B. The Candidate will maintain an 85 average in conduct.
- C. The Candidate will maintain an 85 average in Art Appreciation in his/her sophomore year.
- D. The Candidate will maintain an 85 average in Art I, Art II or Advanced Placement Art in his/her junior and senior year.
- E. The Candidate will enroll in Art I, Art II or Advanced Placement Art as an elective in his/her junior and senior year.
- F. The Candidate will be involved in the following activities throughout his/her four years at Wood:
- Band (marching and/or show band)
 - Chorus
 - Stage Crew
 - Band Front
 - Sound Crew
 - Other activity having been given the prior approval of the Chairman of the Fine Arts Department

Submission of Application and works:

Mr. Tim Dunn, Director of Advancement, will receive all parts of the Portfolio and Application by February 5, 2016 in Room 237.

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Skip Duffy Scholarship Application

Eligibility

- Student must be in good academic standing in current school.
- Financial need. (Finalists will be requested to submit a copy of current federal income tax, which lists student as a dependent or submit an application through PSAS)

Requirements

- Student must be registered to attend Archbishop HS in September 2016.
- Student must attach to this application, a one page letter, stating why he/she wants to attend Archbishop Wood HS. Please include within that letter, any school, community and extra-curricular activities in which you are involved. Name at least one particular accomplishment that you are proud of.
- Student must maintain a "B" average or better each semester while attending Archbishop Wood High School in order to maintain eligibility.

Value

The award is a \$2000.00 scholarship for tuition aid that is applied directly to tuition charges for the 2016-17 school year.

Selection

Selection of the scholarship award will be determined by the Duffy family and any members of a committee chosen by them.
